Though it is impossible to delineate the exact boundaries of the Tribes of Israel with 100% confidence, based on archaeological evidence and a true knowledge of ancient boundary delineation practices, this map is a very accurate representation of what the Biblical boundaries would have been.

Many new discoveries were made during this project that make this map quite unique from previously published tribal boundary maps worldwide. These and many other things will be outlined with the publication of how this map was made.


